

Parking Volunteer Notes



These notes are specific to the YAA program at OSU. If you are interested in starting a YAA program in your community, please download the “Program Handbook” found at <http://youthaviationadventure.org> for the *complete* set of discussion leader notes, along with tips, and other information on how to run this program in your neighborhood.

Setting up the parking:

- Get the signs out of the storage room.
- Each sign has a note on it, indicating where it goes.
- Place the signs in the appropriate spot along the driveway. See map below for an overview.
- Each parking volunteer should wear an orange parking vest.

Staffing the parking:

- One “concierge of parking” standing at the intersection of the grass lot to direct people. This person **MUST** be familiar with everything at the airport and be able to direct people to the various flying clubs, to the terminal, to Young Eagles, to the drop off point, to the restaurant, and to any other point on the airport grounds. See map for the best place for this person.
- 2 people staff the grass lot. One to direct traffic in toward the lot, and another to direct individual cars to park.

Notes:

- YAA volunteers should be parking either on the grass lot, or nearest to the Flight School to leave the spots nearest the terminal for commercial and bizjet patrons.
